What is a Safeguarding Children Partnership?

Solihull Safeguarding Children Partnership is where the Local Authority, Police, and Health professionals have the responsibility to bring all of the agencies that may work or volunteer with children, young people, and families together to ensure that children are kept safe. When these agencies come together, they discuss and consider what are the priorities for safeguarding children.

What if I have an idea to keep children safe?

If you have something that you feel the agencies should consider as a priority for safeguarding children & young people, you should be able to talk with any professional or volunteer in Solihull. They can help you find out more about what is already available or happening that may help, or they can raise your concern to the partnership, if you have identified a gap and a need for something to be given more thought.

What if I don't feel listened to?

If you do not feel that your ideas have been listened to, or acted upon, and you have an idea about something that needs to happen to keep children and young people safe in Solihull, you can email the partnership so that they can consider your idea and let you know what has been decided.
