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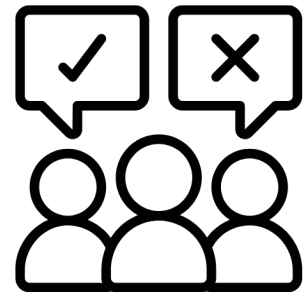
Safer Sleep Week - 11th-17th March 2024

[Domestic Abuse Training Slides](#) and [Attendee Resource Slides](#) have been developed by Solihull Council which

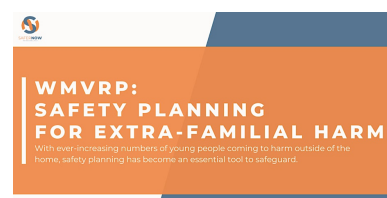
cover the key objectives they would like to consistently be covered in training for domestic abuse. The slides can also be used as they are to deliver training, or can
