St Giles Rescue and Response provides practical support for young people from the West Midlands who have been arrested out of area. We can escort them to a safe place.

How we work:

- Monday-Friday 10.30am-10pm
Saturday and Sunday 10am-6pm
- Assess the suitability of rescue requests on a case-by-case basis
- Engage with young people, helping them to understand the risks of County Lines
- Create safety plans and impart valuable tools for clients to keep themselves safe

- Provide brief one-to-one mentoring interventions to help young people make better-informed decisions
- Use trained County Lines Outreach Workers with lived experience
- Share information with the wider professional network and contribute to the ongoing risk management of young people
