You, or someone who knows you, has raised concerns about your safety. This is what we call a **safeguarding concern.** 

Your views and wishes are important to us. So, we would like to speak to you about what you want us to do.

Our job is to work with you and make sure you are safe, and then to see if there is anything we can do to make things better for you. This is called safeguarding.

## **What Happens Next?**

If we think you are in immediate danger, we will work with you quickly to make you safe. We will explain what is happening.

If we think you are **NOT** in immediate danger, we will talk to you and decide what to do next.

#### **Our Promise to You. We Will:**

- Listen to you.
- Involve you in everything we do.
- Work with you, your representative, or your advocate to make sure you are safe and in control while we make enquiries into the safeguarding concern.
- Explain to you what our concerns are.
- Ask you what you would like to happen.
- Take your concerns seriously.
- Look into your concerns.
- Give you help and support.
