Providing the Right Support at the Right Time



YJS Triage

Purpose:

To identify young people at the earliest opportunity who are on the cusp of offending and offer the necessary support to divert that young person from actual or further offending

Decision Making:

- Includes the voice of the child/family
- Takes into account and includes the voice of the victim, where applicable
- Is joint, involving all partners around the table

Outcomes:

Are based on the needs of the child/family. This can be either a single agency or multi agency response

Risk Management: those young people assessed as posing high risk of offending or serious harm to others, are discussed at monthly multi agency risk management meetings chaired by the YJS. Ensuring irks management has a multi agency approach.

Outcomes

Are based on the needs of the child/family. This can be either a single or multi agency response
We want to make sure we have the greatest impact so ensure the right professionals are involved at the earliest opportunity. Level of support is responsive of need/risk.

Signposting / referrals to other relevant agencies
Early Help Police Intervention
SIAS support
Referral to Health services
Youth Justice Support
